Of course, Kit also performed in countless musicals, and is not at all ashamed to talk about their musical theatre background. It's a huge part of who they are, and how they approach songwriting with storytelling at the forefront.

After giving up music for many years, the global pandemic and several major life events changed everything for Kit. In a short time, Kit suffered a lot of loss. Compounded with the deep isolation and depression many others were going through as well, Kit's dad was diagnosed with and then ultimately passed away from pancreatic cancer after almost a decade of living with younger-onset Alzheimer's disease. Throughout his illness, Kit's weekly YouTube videos brought him joy and comfort even at times when nothing else would reach him. Kit saw the importance of their music, especially for the people they loved, and vowed to learn everything they could to establish themself as an artist full time.

Causes that mean a lot to Kit include Alzheimer's disease awareness, cancer research, LGBTQIA+ rights, uplifting POC and other marginalized voices, science, and education. Many of these themes recur throughout Kit's music and online content, and Kit is not afraid to be open about their opinions, even when they might be considered controversial to some.

Kit has passionately paved their own path and will continue to create relatable music that embraces real-life issues with a kind, earnest touch, and humanity at its core.
